Uashat mak Mani-utenam, October 19, 2022 - The community of Uashat mak Mani-utenam will host, from October 26 to 28, the Education Summit 2022, which will be held under the theme of Mukutakan, the tool used to shape many traditional objects.

Presented by the Conseil Innu Takuaikan Uashat mak Mani-utenam (ITUM) and the Education Sector of ITUM, the Summit will be a unique opportunity for participants to learn and reflect on the educational future of children from a perspective of empowerment and self-governance.

Workshops and conferences will allow participants not only to learn about ITUM's work in education empowerment, but also to better understand the issues related to education management. The Summit will also be a place for exchanges and discussions between participants on the priorities and the future they wish for the education system for children in Uashat mak Mani-utenam.

The Summit, which will take place at the Teueikan Hall in Mani-utenam, is open to anyone interested in the education of Aboriginal children within the ITUM.
